Apply functional job analysis methodology and design graduated Return-to-Work plans. Learn to manage complex cases using a structured decision tree framework, coordinating with insurers, HR and medical professionals.

03 / Applied Practice and Professional Consultation

Develop reflective professional judgement alongside a confirmed industry-partner mentor. Gain real-world exposure through scenario-based Riipen projects. You will be assessed via a capstone project delivered with your industry partner, which you can add to your professional portfolio.
